





MEMORANDUM TO THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

1. The Hon'ble Secretary of Education to start B.A. courses in Rajiv Gandhi College of Dental Sciences of Sir S. Visweswaraiya Education Trust, Bangalore from the year 1994-95 - Reg.

REASONS:

In the writ petition read at (1) above, the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka passed an order directing the Government to accord affiliation forthwith to the Rajiv Gandhi College of Dental Sciences of Sir S. Visweswaraiya Education Trust effective from the academic year 1994-95 and to make suitable arrangements to the University for the same. In the writ appeal read at (2) above, orders were passed by the Hon'ble High Court clarifying that when the learned single judge directed the Government in the above writ petition to grant affiliation, what was intended was that the State Government should grant affiliation as contemplated under the provision of the Karnataka State Universities Act, 1963, namely in writing not by an affiliation or a recommendation to the University to grant affiliation.

2. In the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 10-6-1995 read at (3) above, it has been observed that during the pendency of the writ, the respondent produced the letter dated 29-7-1995 from the Dental Council of India which certifies that this college fulfills the requirements for starting BDS course as per DCI norms and that the recommendation for grant of permission to start BDS course has been made. The Hon'ble Supreme Court observed

that, in view of this fact, it was considered unnecessary to examine the objections raised therein, or to interfere with the directions given by the Hon'ble High Court to the State Government to make a recommendation to the University to grant the affiliation.

3. In the letter read at (4) above, Government have conveyed approval to grant affiliation to the Rajiv Gandhi Dental College of the Sir M. Visweswaraiya Education Trust to start the D.D.S. course from the year 1982-83 with an intake of 40 students only.

4. In the letter read at (5) above, the Registrar, Bangalore University, Bangalore has stated that the University had accorded affiliation to the Rajiv Gandhi College of Dental Sciences with an intake of 40 seats for the year 1992-93. All the affiliated colleges should obtain renewal every year. This college had not applied for the same in the prescribed form and paid the necessary fees. However, the college has applied for renewal in the prescribed form and fees for the years 1993-94 and 1994-95 and further the college has admitted the students during 1993-94 and 1994-95. The Registrar has requested a clarification whether the University was to grant the affiliation to the college for the years 1993-94 and 1994-95.

5. In the letter read at (6) above, the Government requested the University to grant renewal of affiliation to the Rajiv Gandhi College of Dental Sciences from the year 1982-83 onwards, and mentioned therein the facts raised in the University's letter referred to at (3) above.

6. The Government have now decided, in accordance with the above orders of the Hon'ble High Court and Hon'ble Supreme Court to grant permission to the Sir M. Visweswaraiya Education Trust to start the Rajiv Gandhi College of Dental Sciences from the year 1982-83 respectively with an intake of 40 students only. Hence the following order.

D.O. No. 178/198 (M) 56, 24.10.1981, dated 10th October 1981.

After careful consideration, in accordance with the above orders of the Hon'ble High Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court, Government hereby accords permission to the Director, Government Dental College, Bangalore to admit 200 students of the Rajiv Gandhi College of Dental Sciences from the year 1982-83 retrospectively with an intake of 20 students only.
